"The purpose of the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) is to provide homelessness prevention assistance to households who would otherwise become homeless - many due to the economic crisis - and to provide assistance to rapidly re-house persons who are homeless as defined by Section 103 of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11302)." Richland County has subgranted with two non-profits to provide Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing assistance to eligible households. The expected outcomes are to stabilize at risk households and to quickly house those that are homeless by assisting at least 15 Households per quarter.

Of the three (3) subrecipients reported on the Initial Performance Report (IPR), one subrecipient contract was terminated due to HUD response regarding eligible legal services or activities. Since eligible legal activities are limited to providing case management or counseling to program participants, which was not within the scope of services that SC Appleseed Legal Justice Center proposed to provide, this contract was terminated and another funding source (CDBG- Public Service Activity) was identified as a possible funding source to subrecipient. The other two (2) subrecipients are screening individuals for HPRP services or referring to other appropriate agencies for assistance. A total of ten (10) households were served during this quarter. Lessons learned have been clarification of legal services; developing a network within HPRP providers within the State of South Carolina and in particular, Midlands area, to learn the type of referrals each provider will accept. Exchanging contact information regarding HPRP services throughout the Continuum of Care. Such adjustments should assist the HPRP providers in serving more of the at risk or homeless individuals or families in Richland County.
