PRESENTATION

<u>Palmetto Health Richland Memorial Hospital, Annual Spring Public Report</u> – Ms. Ann Pringle Washington and Mr. John Singerling gave a brief update regarding Palmetto Health Richland Hospital.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Recognition for Dr. Sonny White, Midlands Technical College – Mr. Pope and Ms. Paige Greene named Dr. White an honorary Guardian of the Year and presented him with a Guardian CASA bear for donating space at the Airport Midlands Technical College campus for Richland County CASA to host their Volunteers for Youth conference.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

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APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION

A Resolution to Appoint and Commission Paul F. Alcantar as a Code Enforcement Officer for the Proper Security, General Welfare, and Convenience of Richland County – Ms. Scott moved, seconded by Ms. Dickerson, to approve this item. The vote in favor was unanimous.

CITIZENS' INPUT

Mr. Roosevelt Robertson spoke regarding safety improvements on Padgett Road between Hickory Ridge and Baywater Avenue.

Mr. Lee Carroll spoke regarding safety concerns with the Sheriff's Department's 50 Cam machine gun.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mr. Pearce moved, seconded by Mr. Malinowski, to go into Executive Session. The vote in favor was unanimous.

<u>Hobart Road</u> – Ms. Dickerson requested staff to research the cost to connect Hobart Road so that the residents of Longcreek and the new Mungo subdivision will have access to the adjourning road.

<u>Broad River Corridor</u> – Ms. Dickerson requested staff review and make an assessment of the proposed enhancement of the Broad River Road Corridor proposed by Central Midlands.

<u>Holly Ridge Road</u> – Ms. Dickerson requested staff assess the cost of putting a turning lane at the entrance to Holly Ridge Road.

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<u>Costs Adjustment to Residents for Use of Community Centers</u> – Ms. Dickerson requested staff to research an adjustment to the cost to use the community centers for community-related activities for residents of Bonnie Forest and Cedar Creek.

<u>Trash and Drainage Issues</u> – Ms. Dickerson requested that staff review trash and drainage issues and the possibility of using biodegradable bags.

<u>Fair Housing Resolution</u> – Mr. McEachern moved for unanimous consent for a resolution to recognize April as Fair Housing month and designate the County Administrator as the Fair Housing agent for the County. The vote in favor was unanimous.

<u>Detention Center Commission</u> – Mr. Jackson referred to the A&F Committee the formation of a commission for the Detention Center.

<u>Landfill Host Fees</u> – Mr. Jackson referred to the A&F Committee the possibility of landfill host fees being granted to the immediate communities for economic development.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 7:44 p.m.
