PUBLIC HEARING – FY 04-05 Millage Agency Projections

Ms. Scott opened the floor to the public hearing. No one signed up to speak at this time. The floor to the public hearing was closed.

Mr. Harry Huntley, County Auditor, gave a brief overview of the millage agency projections. Mr. Huntley stated Council needed to override millage limitations on a few items which are as follows:

- Operation for School District One – 6.1 mill increase
- Operation for School District Two – 7.6 mill increase
- Recreation Commission - 1.2 mill increase
- General Fund – 1.5 mill increase

He stated the mill did not need to be increased for the Fire Service as projections were lower than expected.
