#### CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Dixon called the meeting to order at approximately 3:04 PM.

#### ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

Mr. Malinowski moved, seconded by Mr. Rush, to include the minutes in the agenda in the future. The vote in favor was unanimous.

#### DIRT ROAD PAVING PROGRAM – STATUS UPDATE

- Dennis Corporation has been working with Transportation Staff to do design build reviews
- 108 roads stayed in after consent/denial
- 7 of the 108 do not require right-of-ways; 6 roads staff will be working to obtain right-of-ways on
- Approximately 13 roads should be ready to go to construction by the end of January
- Groups of 10-12 will go to construction as right-of-way plans are obtained
- Some road may require redesign if property owners do not want their roads paved
- Jouster Road was advertised as a sheltered market to only SLBE firms

Mr. Malinowski requested a copy of the 7 roads that do not require right-of-way.

Mr. Perry will forward the information to the committee.

The OSBO Office tracks the SLBE participation.

Mr. Ozbek stated of the 3,336 roads approximately 350 roads were damaged.
