Bond Court – Judge Simons presented the proposal for 24-hour bond court.

- There were be cost savings to the County (i.e. meal costs, housing/clothing inmates)
- An additional \$281,409 will be needed to implement the proposal
- Solicitor and Sheriff are in favor of the proposal
- The City of Columbia will be requested to participate once the program has been set up
