Consent

- **A.** Request to approve posting of the Civil Rights Act 1968 in County-occupied buildings The committee recommended that council approve the request to post a Civil Rights Act of 1968 poster in county-occupied buildings. The vote in favor was unanimous.
- B. An ordinance providing for entering into a tax-exempt lease purchase transaction of not exceeding \$3,700,000 and a sublease with Allen University, to prescribe the purposes for which the proceeds shall be expended, to provide for the payment thereof, and other matters pertaining thereto The committee voted to refer this item to the Bond Review Committee for consideration.
