Welcome and Call to Order

Chairman Dabney called the meeting to order and announced a quorum in attendance. He welcomed everyone and called for the invocation.

Invocation

Commissioner Cole delivered the invocation.

Election of Officers

Chairman Dabney asks **Commissioner Goudelock** to read the slate for Officers nominated for the upcoming year. **Commissioner Goudelock** read the following names:

Chairman Dabney, per the by laws, opened the floor for additional nominations: there were none. New Officers were unanimously elected by acclamation. **Chairman Dabney** congratulated the newly installed Officers and turned the meeting over to the newly elected **Chairman, Don Purcell.**

Chairman Purcell commended former **Chairman Dabney** on the outstanding leadership he provided to the RCAC the last two years. **Commissioner Dabney** thanked his fellow commissioners for their support.

Adoption of Agenda

Chairman Purcell presented the agenda as drafted. **Commissioner Goudelock** made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented, **Commissioner Cole** seconded, and all approved.

Approval of Minutes

Chairman Purcell presented the minutes of the November 19, 2012 Airport Commission meeting for approval. **Commissioner Goudelock** made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, **Commissioner Cole** second, and all approved.

Presentation - Mr Charlie Farrell, Director, South Carolina Aerospace Task Force

Mr Farrell's charge as Director is to produce a strategic plan within an **18** to **24** month period to enhance the aerospace industry in SC. He is working with the current nine-member task force from throughout our State. He shared the names of the members and gave a brief biography of each member. Mr Farrell stated the importance of communication, maximizing all available opportunities and information regarding the Aerospace Industry across the State. The major concern is the need for workforce development. Mr Farrell stated that **60%** of jobs created come from existing businesses that are currently in the state. Approximately **25%** of jobs in SC require a college degree.

Mr Farrell suggested that our schools re-orient their thought process and start very early exposing students to science and math programs. Because there are **180** businesses in the State which involve aerospace either directly or indirectly (**40** businesses came to SC to support the Boeing plant in Charleston) there is tremendous interest in aerospace in our State. Mr Farrell encouraged that someone from the Airport Commission become a part of an Advisory Board to the task force. **Commissioner Goudelock** asks if there was a dedicated staff for the task force? Mr Farrell answered that there is not, but they are being supported by the resources of the Department of Commerce and that will be a website coming on line soon. **Commissioner Dean** asked which companies, here in the Midlands, support Aerospace? Mr Farrell noted that Zeus Industrial Products Inc was one of those companies. Mr Farrell noted that the task force is working on long term solutions, however, the window of opportunity is short.
