#### Consent

2. Construction Services/Detention Center Chiller Project – The committee recommended that Council approve the request to authorize the Procurement Office, Office of Support Services, and the Sustainability Coordinator to negotiate and award the contract for the EECBG Detention Center Chiller project to begin reducing power consumption and the County's carbon footprint. The vote in favor was unanimous.

#### Consent

Judicial Center and Administration Building Lighting Upgrades – The committee 3. recommended that Council approve the request to authorize the Procurement Office, Office of Support Services, and the Sustainability Coordinator to negotiate and award the contract for the EECBG Judicial Center and Administration Building Lighting upgrades project to begin reducing power consumption and the County's carbon footprint. The vote in favor was unanimous.

4. Kershaw County IGA Screaming Eagle Landfill - The committee recommended that Council approve the IGA with Kershaw County to give Richland County authority to

permit and inspect land disturbance activities for the landfill expansion. The vote in favor was unanimous.

The vote in favor was unanimous.
