### Report of Actions

#### CALL TO ORDER

Valerie Hutchinson called the meeting to order.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Regular Session: February 22, 2011 – The minutes of the February 22, 2011 committee were approved as submitted.

#### ADOPTION OF AGENDA

The agenda was adopted as published.

#### ITEMS FOR ACTION

- Consent** 2. A Resolution in support of Dirt Road Paving Design – The committee recommended that Council table this item. The vote in favor was unanimous.
- Consent** 3. Fire Station Paving: Drives and Parking – The committee recommended that Council approve the request to enter into negotiations and a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, REA Contracting, in the amount of \$ 254,891.05. The vote in favor was unanimous.
4. Hopkins Community Water System Elevated Tank Color and Logo – The committee recommended Council approve staff's recommendation of the tank logo detail as presented in option "A" with the tank color "Teardrop". The vote was in favor.
5. Off-Ramp Lighting – The committee voted to keep this item in committee pending staff providing additional information. The vote in favor was unanimous.

6. Power Line Easement to SCE&G – The committee voted to send this item to Council without a recommendation and directed staff to provide Council with a detailed map of the easement. The vote was in favor.
7. Research and give alternative transportation options for released inmates - The committee recommended that Council re-establish the Ad-Hoc Jail committee to identify drop-off points. The vote was in favor.
- Consent** 8. Shady Wood Lane Improvements Contract – The committee recommended that Council not approve the request to award the construction contract to Cherokee, Inc. in the amount of \$352,000. The vote in favor was unanimous.
