Report of Actions

CALL TO ORDER

Valerie Hutchinson called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Regular Session: September 27, 2011 – The minutes of the September 27, 2011 committee meeting were approved as amended to reflect that the Bath Salts Ordinance item was not acted on by the Committee.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

The agenda was adopted as published.

ITEMS FOR ACTION

2. Ordinance to Prohibit ‘bath salts’ and synthetic marijuana – The committee recommended that Council adopt an ordinance prohibiting “bath salts” and synthetic marijuana. The committee directed the County Attorney’s office to provide an explanation of what is contained in the ordinance as well as provide an explanation of what will happen if a case regarding “bath salts” is not adjudicated. Also, the Sheriff’s Department is to provide Council with a list of the various ‘street names’ for “bath salts”. The vote was in favor.
3. Achieve SC State Solid Waste Diversion Rate of 35% within five years and develop a long range goal for zero waste – The committee deferred this item to its November committee meeting.
4. Expiring Solid Waste curbside collection contracts for areas 2 & 6 – The committee forwarded this item to Council without a recommendation. The vote was in favor.

5. Animal Care Ordinance Revisions - The committee deferred this item to its November committee meeting. Mr. Malinowski will contact staff regarding any concerns he has with the proposed revisions.
- Consent** 6. Decker Blvd/Woodfield Park Neighborhood Redevelopment Overlay District and the Corridor Redevelopment Overlay District – The committee recommended that Council approve the ordinance, but directed staff to look into amending the language so that it would only apply to the Decker/Woodfield Master Plan area; and then send it to the Planning Commission. The vote in favor was unanimous.
7. Review the process of the Development Review Team – The committee deferred this item to its November committee meeting.
8. Proposed Amendment to Settlement agreement with Northeast Landfill – The committee kept this item in committee and requested that all stakeholders weigh in with their opinions by November 10th and that feedback also be obtained from the Conservation Commission. The committee also directed the Clerk of Council’s office to schedule a Public Hearing regarding this item for November 22nd. The vote was in favor.
