### **Report of Actions**

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Committee member Hutchinson called the meeting to order in the absence of Committee Chair Kennedy.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

1. Regular Session: June 26, 2012 – The minutes of the June 26, 2012 committee meeting were approved as submitted.

**ADOPTION OF AGENDA**      The agenda was adopted as published.

#### **ITEMS FOR ACTION**

2. Roadway Lighting on State Right-of-Ways for Commercial Enhancement – This item was deferred until the September committee meeting.
3. Delete the requirement of review fees for Family Property – This item was deferred until the September committee meeting.
4. Broad River Sewer Monthly User Fees – This item remained in committee pending staff from Utilities providing additional information.
5. Road Right-of-Way Acceptance Policy – This item remained in committee pending staff in Public Works addressing the issue of how to deal with paved roads that are not up to county standards.
6. Curfew for Community Safety – This item was forwarded to the September 11, 2012 Council meeting without a recommendation. Staff is to provide Council with a copy of the City of Columbia's curfew ordinance as well as the proposed County curfew's

legislative history, the draft County ordinance, and crime statistics provided by the Sheriff's Department.

- Consent** 7. Amendment to Thomas and Hutton Contract for Floodplain Remapping – The committee recommended that Council table this item. The vote in favor was unanimous.
- Consent** 8. Amendment to Thomas and Hutton Contract for Floodway Remapping - The committee recommended that Council approve the request to amend the existing contract with Thomas and Hutton to re-map the Gills and Crane Creek FIRMs in Zone AE areas by \$27,500. The vote in favor was unanimous.
9. Council District Limits centered on County Maintained Roads – This item remains in committee. Council members are to discuss any issues they may have prior to the September committee meeting and come up with possible solutions regarding same.
10. Amendment to Parking Regulation – This item was deferred until the September committee meeting.
