2. Recycling Collection Agreements with Richland District One, Richland District Two and District 5 of Lexington and Richland Counties: The Committee recommended that Council authorize staff to engage in discussions and negotiations with Richland District One, Richland District Two and District Five of Lexington and Richland Counties to develop an agreement to have their schools added to the County's curbside recycling collection routes and provide recycling roll carts. Council Motion Regarding Engineering and Construction Assistance from the South Carolina National Guard: The Committee recommended that Council direct staff to request engineering and construction assistance from the South Carolina National Guard for the dams located within the County that were damaged by the October 2015 flooding event and remain in disrepair. **CONSENT**

Building Services: Adoption of the 2015 Code Editions: The Committee recommended that Council approve the request to amend Chapter 6 of the Richland Council Code of Ordinances to adopt the 2015 editions of the South Carolina Residential Code, South Carolina Building Code, South Carolina Plumbing Code, South Carolina Mechanical Code, South Carolina Fire Code, South Carolina Fuel Gas Code, South Carolina Existing Building Code, International Swimming Pool and Spa Code, International Property Maintenance Code and the 2014 National Electrical Code. **CONSENT**
