

a. Board of Zoning Appeals - 2

ITEMS FOR ACTION

a. Move that the Rules & Appointments Committee review the current County Council Rules and offer amendments for consideration by Council that would clarify exactly how County Council voting will occur with specific reference to how a non-vote (i.e. not a "yes", "no" or "abstain" vote) from a member present at the meeting shall be counted or not counted [PEARCE] – Mr. Malinowski stated the proposed language from Mr. Farrar is as follows: Each member shall vote on each question put. No member shall be permitted to vote on any question in which that member has a direct personal or pecuniary interest, or in which that member perceives that he or she has a direct personal or pecuniary interest, or in which his or her participation might create an appearance of impropriety in that member's estimation. A Council member must be at his/her seat in order to vote for those at the dais. If a member does not declare a vote or an abstention, such member shall not be considered to have voted for either the prevailing or for the non-prevailing side, but instead shall not have his or her vote recorded at all on the question put.

Mr. Malinowski stated we are changing is so we do not go around with prevailing side, not prevailing side. If you do not vote, you do not vote. It does not count. You are on nobody's side. The vote stands as it is. If it is a tie vote, it fails.

Ms. McBride stated, for clarification, that Mr. Rose was not at his seat during a meeting and he was allowed to vote.

Mr. Malinowski stated that was a Special Called Meeting. Our rules say you can call in to a Special Called Meeting.

Mr. N. Jackson stated he thinks when you vote other people should not have to see if you vote, just the results

Mr. Malinowski stated Mr. N. Jackson's concern will have to come back as a separate motion.

Ms. McBride moved, seconded by Ms. Kennedy, to forward to Council with a recommendation for approval. The vote in favor was unanimous.

It is the policy of Richland County to require disclosure of any personal or financial interest that may be influenced by decisions of the Committee, Board or Commission for which any citizen applies for membership.

Such conflict of interest does not preclude service but shall be disclosed before appointment. The Clerk of Council shall be notified of any change on an annual basis and members of all Committees, Boards or Commissions shall be required to abstain from voting or influencing through discussion or debate, or any other way, decisions of the Committee, Board or Commission affecting those personal and financial interests.

All statements so filed shall be signed and verified by the filer. The verification shall state that the filer has used all reasonable diligence in its preparation, and that to the best of his or her knowledge, it is true and complete.

Any person who willfully files a false or incomplete statement of disclosure or no change of condition, or who willfully fails to make any filing required by this article, shall be subject to such discipline, including censure and disqualification from the Committee, Board or Commission, by majority vote of the council.
