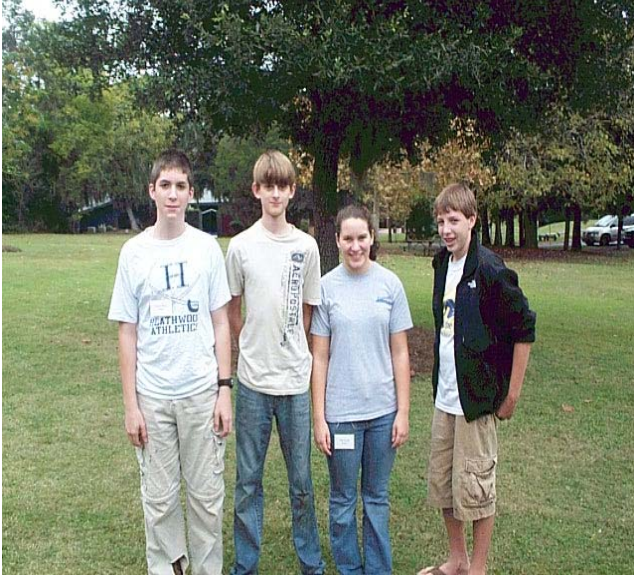


# Carolina Coastal Adventure 2008
