On Friday evening, October 5<sup>th</sup>, the weekend will begin with an Evening of BBQ, Blues & Jazz at the historic Harriet Barber House, 116 Barberville Loop and Lower Richland Boulevard, off Garners Ferry Road, Hopkins, SC. Tickets for this fundraiser are \$15.00 (\$20.00 – day of event) V.I.P. packages are also available. Ticket prices include admission, entertainment and food. All proceeds will benefit SERCO's educational component. The host for the evening will be "Still Bill" Alston of Beale Street on WLXC Kiss 103.1FM. The concert will begin at 7:00 PM and will feature Katrina Garvin of Columbia, SC Second Nature of Camden, SC, and Carlos Santan of Atlanta, GA - back by popular demand.
